THE GLOBAL LEGAL industry saw a seismic shift last week, with the partnerships with Herbert Smith Freehills, widely acknowledged as one of the world's most elite law firms, and top US law firm Kramer Nevin Naftalis & Franklin voting to approve a historic merger. The new entity will have 2,700 lawyers and an estimated \$2 billion in revenue and 26 offices worldwide. While the merger may not impact the domestic legal industry immediately, top-tier Indian law firms have also started taking baby steps to consolidate in a bid to create specialised giant legal entities.

Neha Sharma, founder and had of Avimukta, a well-known legal recruitment consultancy, says "What we are seeing now is a move back to safe, compliance-driven tier-1 firms which offer sustainability over longer periods of time. Indian law firms are also entering a critical consolidation and hiring phase, with top-tier firms picking up rainmakers from the market along with their teams."

Sharma adds that this trend is not only about expanding headcount but strategically building capability in specialised practice areas. "Most leading firms are investing heavily in top-dollar talent to enhance their bench strength in niche sectors. Inorganic hirings also proving to be a gateway for firms to enter or bolster verticals where they previously had limited presence. This includes hiring senior lawyers along with their teams and client relationships, allowing firms to absorb fully-formed practices overnight," she explains.

Large firms now offer seasoned lawyers a platform with deep pockets and a longer runway to establish themselves before being expected to perform. "There is a runway given to top lawyers from smaller or

mid-tier firms, who are on boarded by large firms with the understanding that the first year is for consolidation. This approach allows firms to strategically fill gaps in their service offerings by acquiring teams that are ready to deliver from day one," she concludes.

A top-tier firm which is creating a buzz in the domestic legal firmament is full service law firm JSA. Amar Gupta, Joint Managing Partner, JSA Advocates & Solicitors, says the consolidation is a function of the country's economic growth. JSA has been on an expansion drive over the last one year. He maintains that "as large and complex assignments become more common, the size and scale of law firms play a crucial role in execution. This consolidation is occurring through both organic expansion and inorganically through lateral hires and strategic mergers."

JSA has onboarded seven equity partners through the lateral route over the past few

months with most coming in with teams while also organically promoting nine of its internal retained partners to equity partnership, reflecting significant expansion. Prior to 2024, JSA primarily followed an organic growth model. Since last year, however, the firm has started inorganic growth which entails lateral hiring as well. What attracts lawyers to JSA, Gupta says, is not only the work culture but also the fact that it is a firm with no promoter family, and the compensation structure rewards merit and performance. "Over time, we have kept pace with the emerging aspirations of the new generation of professionals coming into the industry," he adds.

The equity partners who have joined JSA include infrastructure and projects focussed partners Arun Kumar and Deepak Chowdhury who have moved from mid-tier firm Indus Law along with 13 other lawyers, mergers and acquisitions rainmaker Iqbal Khan

from Shardul Amarchand Mangaldas along with a team of 20 lawyers, Trilegal antitrust head Nisha Kaur Uberoi along with her team of 23 fee-earners, S&R Partner Divyanshu Pandey and very recently, Luthra & Luthra's banking and finance partner Karan Mitroo with his team of 15 attorneys. Exults Gupta, "This speaks volumes for the success of our model wherein talent compensation is fair and transparent, based purely on merit and performance. This season of revelation, he has already gobbled up nine scalps in four games, more than half the wickets he had managed from thrice as many games last edition, four of them arriving against former team Sunrisers Hyderabad.

In his burst of 4-0-17-0 on Sunday, he demonstrated all his wares. His lethal out-swing, the wobble-seaming devil that holds the line or break back into the right-handed batsman, the cross-seamed cutter delivered without a marked change in arm speed, the inch-perfect in-swinging yorker on middle and leg stump and the clever short-ball. He showed his most impor-

tant attribute too—the jaan laga denge" attitude.

His Hyderabad teammate Akshath Reddy sheds more light on his personality, traits that spreadsheets cannot quantify. "He is mentally tough." "He has the jaan laga denge attitude. Even if a couple of matches don't go his way he won't feel down. He will pick himself up," he says. "He wants to give his 150%. He is not worried about injuries he might sustain when trying hard. Whenever there is a setback he tries harder to give a comeback and this is his USP," he adds.

Siraj's resurgence has arrived at a time when his value with the white-ball has been questioned and put him on the fringes of the Indian setup

been questioned. He has featured in neither white-ball formats for his country this year, despite impressive numbers and remarkable fitness. Even his jaan laga denge attitude has been put to test. He has been on the fringes of the Indian set up recently, including for the Champions Trophy. Rohit Sharma and the selectors reportedly pointed to his struggles with the old ball as the reason for his omission.

Comeback push

But in childhood coach Kudaravalli Srinivas, he has a voice of empathy. "Siraj has been performing at a high level for seven to eight years. Players eventually experience fatigue—there are bound to be phases where form dips," said Srinivas.

"He's played continuously: Test series, Asia Cups, IPLs—no break, no rest for the mind. It's more mental fatigue than physical. When that sets in, performances dip, and that's when a break is needed. The team management should have given him a mistake," he explains.

He is a soft guy from inside, the coach says. "You saw how emotional he got when he saw Virat Kohli during the game against RCB. He's a soft guy inside, an innocent guy who only knows how to bowl fast," Srinivas says. "He doesn't understand politics. Have you ever seen him make a controversial statement?" he asks.

Besides, the M Chinnaswamy could be a cruel ground for a pacer. The short dimensions of the ground, where even a top-edge could comfortably soar for a six, lack of a resourceful support cast and the flatness of the pitch all contributed to his unflattering figures with RCB last year.
